



## Transportation Maintainer Registered Apprentice Program

CTDOT's Transportation Maintainer Registered Apprentice Program offers one year of paid on-the-job training and classroom instruction, equipping participants with the skills needed to excel as a Transportation Maintainer 2 upon completion of the program. Applicant must have the following qualifications prior to applying:

- A valid Commercial Learner's Permit (CLP) with air brakes and tanker endorsement
- A valid Medical Examiner's Card (MEC)

### Preferred prior experience or coursework includes:

- Construction
- Landscaping
- Snowplowing

## Bridge Maintenance

CTDOT bridge maintenance workers help to ensure that bridges remain reliable and safe by performing a variety of tasks, including:

- Regularly inspecting bridges for structural integrity and identifying factors that could impact safety
- Performing necessary repairs to restore bridges including patching, replacing components and reinforcing structures
- Implementing routine maintenance to ensure the longevity of bridges



## Highway Maintenance

CTDOT highway maintenance workers keep roads in good condition by performing a variety of tasks, including:

- Repairing and patching roads, fixing pavement, potholes, and guiderails
- Operating snowplows and salt spreaders during the winter months, and removing debris, brush and undergrowth to keep roads clear and safe to travel
- Performing drainage and catch basin maintenance
- Street sweeping, mowing and tree maintenance



## Electrical

CTDOT electrical workers focus on maintaining and improving the electrical systems that support our transportation infrastructure by performing a variety of tasks, including:

- Installing repairing and maintaining traffic signals to ensure they operate safely and correctly
- Managing and maintaining street lighting and highway illumination systems to enhance visibility for drivers and pedestrians
- Conducting regular inspections of electrical systems to identify and fix any issues



## Repair

CTDOT repair workers maintain and repair various heavy-duty vehicles and specialized transportation equipment by performing a variety of tasks, including:

- Using diagnostic tools to identify vehicle issues
- Perform mechanical repairs, including engine work, brake systems, electrical systems and more
- Conduct regular maintenance including oil changes, tire rotations and inspections
- Maintain detailed records of repairs and maintenance performed



## Signs & Markings

CTDOT signs and markings workers ensure that roadways are clearly marked, and that all signage is functional and compliant with safety regulations by performing a variety of tasks, including:

- Applying paint for lane markings, crosswalks and other long line markings to ensure proper traffic guidance
- Maintaining existing signs, repairing any damage and replacing outdated or non-compliant signage
- Preparing road surfaces for new markings, ensuring compliance with design specifications and regulations

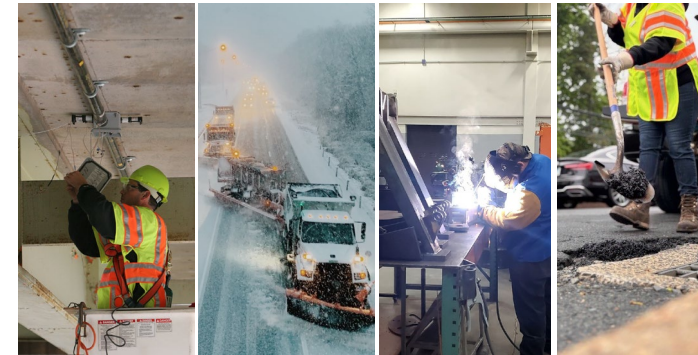
